Qualifications

- ⇒ 15 years old or completed 10th grade
- ⇒ Camped with us one week minimum
- ⇒ Manifest Christian leadership traits
- ⇒ Desire to work with children
- ⇒ Two recommendations by pastor or Christian leader

GUIDELINES:

1. The entire course takes at least two summers (two weeks each summer) plus two weekends between the first and second year programs.
2. A CILT will serve as a Junior Counselor for one week in the second summer.
3. Attendance at Pre-Camp Training is required prior to the second summer.
4. The CILT pays the regular camp fees (weekly and weekend fee) for each summer. No fee required for the Junior Counseling week.
5. CILTs will be evaluated at the end of the first summer and again at the spring weekend before continuing with the program.
6. Completion of the CILT course does not guarantee a future Cedarbrook Camp staff position.
